Step 7, Tradition 7 and Concept 7

Step 7

Step 7 of AA is a step that involves humility and reliance on a higher power. It is part of the AA program for recovery from alcoholism. In this step, individuals in recovery ask the higher power to remove their shortcomings and give them strength and self-control. They also learn to practice honesty, tolerance, and true love of man and God1. This step helps them to change their perspective from a self-centered one to a humble, selfless one.

Tradition 7

Tradition 7 of Alcoholics Anonymous is about being fully self-supporting and declining outside contributions. This means that only AA members can donate money to AA, and there is a limit on how much they can give. The money collected is used for group expenses and for carrying the message of AA on a world wide basis. This tradition reflects the principle that each member is responsible for his or her own recovery.

Concept 7

Concept 7 is one of the Twelve Concepts of Alcoholics Anonymous. It states that the Charter and the Bylaws of the General Service Board are legal instruments, and that the Trustees are fully empowered to manage and conduct all of the world service affairs of Alcoholics Anonymous. Step 7 of AA's 12 steps for recovery encourages people to practice humility by asking a higher power to remove shortcomings and replace them with spiritual practices. Tradition 7 of AA says that every group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions.
