Apr. 1	1939	Alcoholics Anonymous, the Big Book was published		
	1966	Sr. Ignatia died at age 77. She worked with Dr. Bob treating many early AA members at St. Thomas Hospital in Akron, OH		
3	1941	The first Florida AA meeting took place		
4	1960	The Chicago Daily News reported that Fr. Edward Dowling, Jesuit Priest who helped start the first AA group in St. Louis, died at age 62		
7	1941	Ruth Hock reported that there were 1,500 letters asking for help, as a result of the Jack Alexander article in the Saturday Evening Post		
10	1939	The first ten copies of the Big Book arrived in Bill's office
