Summary

Thank you for the opportunity to be of service in the capacity of webmaster for Area 82 NFLD/LAB/NS.

I've been in the role for almost one year now and while I've made some changes to the site, I've kept the original integrity of the design package as it is quite sound and user friendly.

Since my last update in October the most significant changes have been:

- Preparing the position page for the available positions and then updating the contact list with the newly elected individuals.
- For the newly elected individuals there was an onboarding piece for their area82aa.org emails. This onboarding was a challenge as the webmail hosting we use is called "Bluehost/Roundcube", while it operates as a typical webmail, it is not as user friendly as "Outlook" or "Gmail". Once everyone was successfully logged in and we forwarded emails to services that were more familiar it seemed to be smoother for folks.
- One of the issues with Roundcube is the number of phishing emails or scams we receive. I checked with Blue Host/Roundcube, and all correct security settings are in place.
 - I researched a new webmail server and spoke with the previous webmaster for aahalifax.org and he made a few suggestions but also noted that each one will cost more money, and we will essentially get the same level of service that we have now with Roundcube. He did not recommend us moving our emails to Gmail as it is too challenging to oversee the security. To get the same level of security access we currently have it would cost significantly more with Gmail.
 - My recommendation is to stay with Roundcube. The onboarding learning curve can be steep, but it will be the same for most webmail servers. Since folks can have their emails forwarded to the email service of their choice, they log into Roundcube rarely. Which mitigates the frustration.
- I've added alert banners to the site to call attention to important events.
- Completed all normal website updates such as meeting updates, newsletter updates, event additions, meeting minute updates as well.
- I answered 3 inquiries from people who were looking to attend a first meeting and unsure what to expect.
- There was one flyer that was added that seemed to be solely an AI Anon roundup and it was questioned by a member, so the flyer was removed. After speaking with the round up committee they assured me it was indeed an AA round up and they updated their flyer to show the AA logo. The flyer was re published.

- I removed a section of the website that was related to Covid-19 protocols. The page had several broken links to old Covid information and was no longer relevant.
- Updated the Box 459 and the Service Manual links
- Removed several gigabytes of old flyers and newsletters. Kept approximately the last 2 years

On deck for changes/updates:

- Update the AA Resource page
- Add a link to the AA Podcast
- Revise the events page so it is clickable images
- Tidy up the header as there are items out of line

Budget:

- October will be the next draw on the budget. It will be for the full \$49.17

Area 82 Site Stats


Difference between “views” and “visits.”

- Views can help us understand the popularity of specific pages, while visitors can give us an idea of the overall reach and popularity of the site.


All Time Highlights

March 31st we had the most views at 520!


Sunday night at 9pm seems to be a popular time for folks to be interested in AA




We average 260 views per day, which is pretty good!
