We meet on Saturday nights at 6:30. In February we started doing a Big Book Study, with an open speaker meeting on the last Saturday of the month. We have Approx. 50 AA Members in District 17. Being a small District with groups in fairly close proximity of each other we support each other's AA group. District 17 stretches West of Mt Uniacke, exit 3 on the 101 and East of Greenwich, Exit 11 on the 101. We have 7 registered Groups in District 17 and 1 meeting, with a total of 11 meetings per week. District 3 and 17 work jointly on putting meetings on at Crosbie House Society on Tuesday nights and Bridging the Gap for the 28-day Treatment facility.

Our entertainment Committee has been busy with some new ideas, today we are having a Games Day with some light refreshments from 1-5 at the Brooklyn meeting location in Sweets Corner. This year will not be holding the campout in August, instead we will be having a Family Picnic Day on July 19th. So, if you wish to camp, it will be your responsibility to book your campsite. The Windsor and Area Mini Round-up will held in August from the 15th-17th.

I want to thank the Groups and members of District 17 allowing me privilege to serve as DCM this rotation.
